Timber Pre-Sale Forester Trainer

Senior Service America, Inc. is recruiting for a Timber Pre-Sale Forester Trainer position in the pilot FS-ACES Program (55 years of age or older) at the Superior National Forest, in Ely MN.

Role: Trains and coaches Forest Service employees performing duties specifically related to boundary line location, including record research, field location, developing contract scope of work, inspection, and review of contracted work in support of Timber Sale location. Mentors land surveyor-in-training and timber staff.

Responsibilities:

- Mentors and advises Timber Sales Administrators and Surveyor in training in the process of identifying boundary line needs to support proposed timber sales, reviewing survey records applicable to proposed sales, and strategic packaging for boundary location contracting.
- Provides guidance and advice in field reconnaissance for GLO property corners and evidence of historical boundary marking or cutting.
- Provides guidance and advice on appropriate use of GPS equipment for boundary line location.
- Support Forest Service staff in preparing scope of work for boundary location contract task orders. Train Forest Service staff how to do contract negotiation and how to inspect contract work.

Qualifications and Education Requirements: Must be able to pass a Federal Background check; Age 55+; BA/BS in Agriculture, natural resources, agronomy or related field of study; 15 years of related experience; Licensed to practice land surveying by the Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design; Physical requirements include the dexterity to reach, stand, climb, move, considerable walking, stooping, bending, lifting up to 100 pounds and the ability to work outside in environmental conditions. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of this position.

Must possess:

- A valid driver's license.
- Ability to coordinate and plan timber sale administration needs.
- Knowledge of forestry land management theories, concepts, and practices.
- Skill in communication and interpersonal relations.
